Wis notes read:40.00 a fir 4 ins dia which I marked 1/4S on W face for 1/4 sec cor. from which a pine 7 ins dia brs S70°W 102 lks dist-marked 1/4 S B.T. A fir 3 ins dia brs N7°E, 15 lks dist-marked 1/4 S B.T. In 1982, PLS 933 remonumented this corner. His record reads: Found 10" Pine fallen down and slid downhill 12' from roothole fragments of

Scribing and BT scribe are visible Index P-5 Set 2 1/2" Aluminum cap on 2 1/2" x 30" Aluminum Pipe stamped as shown at original position N 70°E 67.3 from center of roothole. Scribed Two Trees. A Fir 8" in dia. bears S 44°E 1.8 feet A Fir 10"dia. bears N 02 1/2°W 29.7 feet. Trees have Brass Washer 033 on BT blaze. Description of corner evidence found:

Found the aluminum pipe as described from which a 15" dbh Douglas Fir with partially healed blaze bears N5°05'W, 29.1' and a 10" dbh Douglas Fir with a healed blaze bears S44°E, 1.8'. The trees had grown around the nails attaching the (bearing tree) BT

The trees had grown around the nails attaching the (bearing tree) BT and (land survey monument) LSM signs. A fiberglass post with attached property boundary and LSM signs was set 5.5' south and 1.1' west of the monument.


Description of monument and accessories l'established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Free bearings determined from traverse and earlier sunshot. Pailed the nails holding the signs to the living BT's and reattached the Syns 1" out from the trees. Set two new bearing trees. A 8" dbh Douglas Di Bears NT1446'W, T.6' scribed 1/4 S13 BT in a double blaze. T" dbh Ponderosa Pine bears N T9004'E, T3.3' scribed 1/4 S20 BT in a Soble blaze.

in aluminum washer stamped RLS 852 is nailed between the letters B and T is each lines. Attached BT and LSM signs to these trees. Painted 6" red baseds around all four trees and painted the scribe blazes red.
