A 15" lodgepole pine bears S75-30E, 60.78ft. to the center of the tree. Scribed T1N R38E S26 BT.

An $8^{\prime\prime}$ lodgepole pine bears S20W, 19.66 ft. to the center of the tree. Scribed T1N R38E S27 BT.

A 14" lodgepole pine bears N31W, 13.8 ft. to the center of the tree. Scribed T1N R38E S22 BT.
