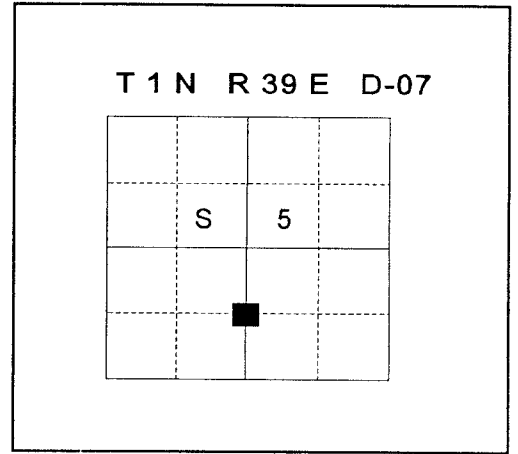


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:
Corner not set by original GLO Survey.

No subsequent monumentation of this corner found in the Union County monumentation records.



DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found no evidence of any monument representing this corner.

See Survey Number 032-1997.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 28" in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 5" diameter Tamarack bears S 40°E, a distance of 37.97 feet, marked X BT.
A 7" diameter White Fir bears S 8°W, a distance of 28.41 feet, marked CS 1/16 S5 BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 2 feet North.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on October 21, 1997.

I used a magnetic compass and steel tape in the establishment of the accessories to this corner. I used a magnetic declination of 18° East. The distance to the bearing trees is to a 50d spike driven on the right side of the tree at the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 2219 to the BT blaze.
