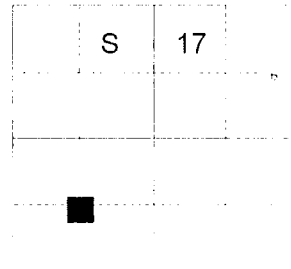

A 12 inch Dia. Douglas Fir bears N 73° E, a distance of 96.66 feet, marked SW 1/16 S17 X BT

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on July 31, 1998.

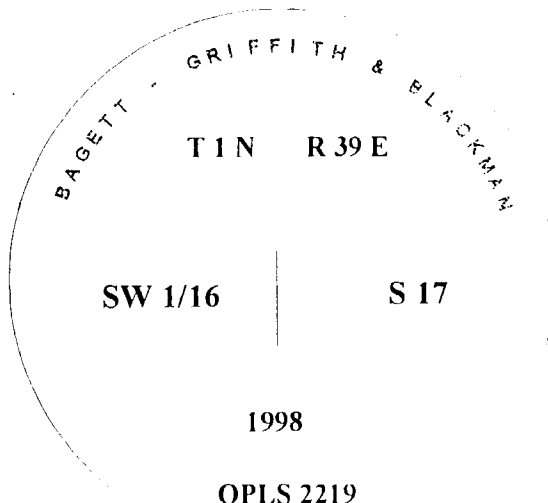

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 18° East declination. Distances are to a 60d spike driven into the root crown of the bearing tree in the right side. A brass washer marked OPLS 2219 was attached to the BT blaze.
