Record states:


Set ¼ sec cor. drove charred stake and raised stone mound as per instructions.

Corner found in 2023 as per CS no. 021-2023 by Greg E. Flowers, PLS 02820 as filed in the Union county surveyor's office.

I found the remnants of a stone mound at the corner location. No new monument was set at the time of this survey.





#### **Description of evidence found:**

Found a stone mound at the corner location.

# Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the location of this corner.

Set an aluminum pipe, 2 ½ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 15 ins. above the ground with a 4 ft. diam. stone mound, with 3 ¼ ins. aluminum cap mkd. as shown.


New Accessories:

An iron rod, 5/8 ins. diam. by 30 ins. long, with aluminum cap, 2 ins. diam. marked RM 1, bears N. 35° E., 9.1 ft. dist. An iron rod, 5/8 ins. diam. by 30 ins. long, with aluminum cap, 2 ins. diam. marked RM 1, bears S. 52° E., 8.9 ft. dist. A basalt stone, 1 ft. by 1 ft. by 1 ft., bears S 53° W., 53 ft. dist., marked XBO 1. A basalt stone, 1 ft. by 2 ft. by 3 ft., bears N 73° W., 66 ft. dist., marked XBO 2.

Bearings are made with a hand compass, magnetic declination = 15°E.
