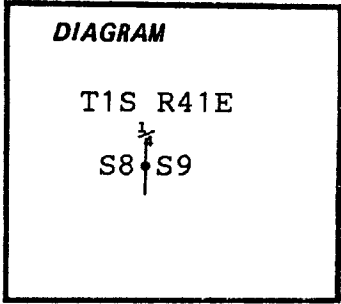


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. G-09

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established in 1898 by A. Gesner under contract #683. At the corner, he set a Basalt stone, 15"x5"x6", 10" in the ground. From which:
A 10" Fir bears S24 $\frac{3}{4}$ °E, 52 lks.
A 16" Tamarack bears S52 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 11 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found 8"x3" basalt stone with '1/2' on West face, rising 10", firmly set and undisturbed.

BT's Found:

A 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " dead standing Tamarack bears S52 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 11 lks. Blaze healed.
A 21" Fir bears S24 $\frac{3}{4}$ °E, 52 lks, blaze healed.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Corner falls in Eagle Cap Wilderness Area, and was left undisturbed.

From the point of Mt. Moriah, toe of 200 ft. high cliff, go North $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, corner is halfway between the steep slope of Mt. Moriah to the west, and the steep breaks of the Minam River to the East, on East slope.
