Corner established by Frank W. Campbell under Contract No 468 dated April 12, 1883, page 24, of the Government Field Notes.
North between Sections 22 and 23, variation $20 \frac{1}{4}$ East.
Set post $4 \frac{1^{\prime}}{}{ }^{\prime}$ long, $4^{\prime \prime}$ square, with marked stone $24^{\prime \prime}$ in ground for corners to. Sections 14, 15, 22, and 23 marked
T 2 NR 38E S 14 on NE, S 23 on SE, S 22, on SW and S 15 on NW face with 3 notches on South edge and 2 notches on East edge

from which: $\quad$ A fir $30^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $N 41^{\circ} \mathrm{E} 21$ ks. marked T $2 \mathrm{~N} R .38 \mathrm{E}$ S 14 BT .
A fir $10^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $S .76^{\circ} \mathrm{E} 9$ lis. marked T $2 \mathrm{~N} R 38 \mathrm{E} 23 \mathrm{BT}$
A tamarack $20^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $S^{\prime \prime} 65^{\circ} \mathrm{W} 14$ lis. marked T 2 N R $38 \mathrm{E} S 22$ BT.
A spruce $8^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $N 68^{\circ}$. W 57 lis. marked T $2 N$ R 38 ES 15 BT.
This corner set September 6, 1883.
No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records.
zuscription of corner evidence found:
I found a fir $36^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $\mathrm{N} 41^{\circ} \mathrm{E} 13.86^{\prime}$ dead standing with scribing visible. I found a fir stump 27' in diam. $2^{\prime \prime}$ high with scribe marks visible on sliver $5^{\prime \prime}$ out from the center of the stump.

I set a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 30^{\prime \prime}$ iron pipe $24^{\prime \prime}$ in the ground with a brass cap marked as shown.

A fir $32^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $\mathrm{N} 02^{\circ}{ }^{\circ} \mathrm{W} 45.0^{\prime}$ scribed T $2 \mathrm{~N} R 38 \mathrm{E}$ S 15 BT.
A fir $16^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $N 48^{\circ} \mathrm{W} 45.0^{\prime}$ scribed T 2 NR 38 E S 15 BT.
A fir $21^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $S 74^{\circ}$ E $42.2^{\prime}$ scribed T $2 N R$ SsE $S 23$ BT.
A fir $8^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $\mathrm{S} 03^{\circ} \mathrm{W} 26.3^{\prime}$ scribed T 2 N R 38 E S 22 BT .
I nailed BT posters and attention signs to CTs.
I nailed brass washers marked PLS 1097 to BT blaze of BIs.
I set a steel post $l^{\prime}$ South with an attention sign.
I painted a red band and scribed blazes of ATs.
I used a staff compass with $21^{\circ}$ declination and a steel chain, measuring distances horizontally.
I placed a poster on a jeep trail $N 30^{\circ}$ E 175 ' to corner from jeep trail on middle ridge. This corner was set September 9, 1979. Witness by Patrick L. Murphy
