at the position described above, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe 26" in the ground with an aluminum cap marked as shown. 24" fir snag at position. From which I scribed BTs:

A spruce 7" in diam. bears N 57°51' E 69.4' marked T 2N R 38E S

A spruce 7" in diam. bears S $78^{\circ}26$ ' E 71.4' marked T 2N R 38E S 26

A fir 17" in diam. bears N $46^{\circ}38$ ' W 68.0' marked T 2N R 38E S 22 BT. A fir 15" in diam. bears S $55^{\circ}05$ ' W 54.3' marked T 2N R 38E S 27 BT.

I nailed a brass washer marked OPLS 1097 to BT blazes.

I set a steel fence post 3' North with signs 54-4 and 54-9.

I painted a red band around BTs and face of scribe.

I used a steel tape and Wild T-2 and measured a horizontal distance to the center of the BTs.
