At the position described above, I set a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 30^{\prime \prime}$ aluminum pipe $26^{\prime \prime}$ in the ground marked as shown.

From which I scribed BTs:
A fir $11^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $\mathrm{N}^{\prime} 11^{\circ} 30$ W $25.5^{\prime}$ scribed $\mathrm{CN} 1 / 16 \mathrm{~S} 28 \mathrm{BT}$
A spruce $17^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $N 76^{\circ} 18^{\prime}$ E $48.6^{\prime}$ scribed $\mathrm{CN} 1 / 16 \mathrm{~S} 28$

I nailed a brass washer marked OPLS 1097 to BT blazes.


I set a steel fence post. $5^{\prime}$ North with signs 54-2 and 54-4.

I painted a red band around BTs and face of scribe.
I used a steel tape and Wild T-2 and measured a horizontal distance to the center of the BTs.
