At the position described above, I set a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on a $2 \frac{1}{2} " \times 30^{\prime \prime}$ aluminum pipe $22^{\prime \prime}$ in the ground marked as shown. I raised a stone mound around the cap.

From which I scribed BTs:
A fir $11^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $S 12^{\circ} 06^{\prime}$ E $31.5^{\prime}$ scribed NE $1 / 16$ S 28 BT.
A fir $13^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $S 86^{\circ} 48^{\prime}$ E $23.6^{\prime}$ scribed NE $1 / 16$ S 28 BT.
I nailed a brass washer marked OPLS 1097 to BT blazes.
I set a steel fence post. $5^{\prime}$ South with signs 54-2 and 54-4.
I set a fiberglass fence post 5 ' West with sign 54-2.
I painted a red band around BTs and face of scribe.
I used a steel tape and Wild T-2 and measured a horizontal distance to the center of the BTs.
