80.00 chains. Set fir post $4 \frac{1}{2}$ ' long, $4^{\prime \prime}$ square, with marked stone $24^{\prime \prime}$ in the ground marked $T 2 N, S 27$ on Northeast face, R 38E S 34 on Southeast face, S 28 on Northwest face, and S 33 on Southwest face with 1 notch on South edge and 3
 notches on East edge. From which:

A fir 18" in diam. bears $N 30^{\circ}$ E 48 lks. marked T $2 N R$ R 38 E S 27 BT . A fir $10^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $S 23^{\circ}$ E ll lks. marked T $2 \mathrm{~N} R$ R 38 E S 34 BT .
A fir $10^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $S 23^{\circ}$ W ll lks. marked T $2 \mathrm{~N} R$ 38E S 33 BT .
A fir $20^{\prime \prime}$ in diam. bears $\mathrm{N} 16^{\circ} \mathrm{W} 24$ lks. marked T 2 N R 38 E S 28 BT.

At the position described above, I set a $2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 30^{\prime \prime}$ aluminum pipe $26^{\prime \prime}$ in the ground with an aluminum cap marked as shown.

From which I scribed BTs:



I nailed a brass washer marked OPLS 1097 to BT blazes.
I set a steel fence post $5^{\prime}$ North with signt 54-4 \& 54-2 \& 5'Eest with sign 54-2
I painted a red band around BTs and face of scribe.
I used a steel tape and $T-2$ Theodolite to measure to the Center of BT
