

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position described above, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe 28" in the ground marked as shown.

From which I scribed BTs:

A fir 13" in diam. bears N $53^{\circ}14'$ W 12.4' scribed CN 1/16 S 33 BT. A fir 9" in diam. bears S $07^{\circ}16'$ E 23.8' scribed CN 1/16 S 33 BT.

I nailed a brass washer marked OPLS 1097 to BT blazes.

I set a fiberglass post 5' North and 5' East with signs 54-2 and 54-2 and 4.

I painted a red band around BTs and face of scribe.

 ${\rm I}$ used a steel tape and Wild T-2 and measured a horizontal distance to the center of the BTs.

This corner was set October 30, 1980. Witness by Patrick L. Murphy.
