

A 15" White Fir bears South 49° East a dist. of 7.85 ft., marked N 1/16 S7 BT. A 9" White Fir bears South 1° West a dist. of 8.35 ft., marked N 1/16 S12 BT. An 8" Engleman Spruce bears North 34° West a dist. of 13.45 ft., marked N 1/16 S12 BT.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. North

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I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 13° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
