
History of original corner establishment:



Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At proportionate distance, I took a 7 inch red fir tree for the corner. I scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S17 on the North face and $\frac{1}{4}$ S20 on the South face, from which;

A 18 inch dia. red fir bears \$30°W, 11.7 feet, marked 4 S20 BT

A 16 inch dia. tamarack bears N48°W, 49.3 feet, marked 坛 \$17 BT

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass with 18° East declination in the establishment of these accessories. I set a brass washer marked OPLS 991 by the BT scribe, all distances were measured to the center of the trees.
