A Pine $26^{\prime \prime}$ in diameter bears $\mathrm{N} 57^{\circ} \mathrm{E}, 87 \mathrm{Lks}$. distance.
A Pine $34^{\prime \prime}$ in diameter bears $\mathrm{N} 38^{\circ} \mathrm{W}, 67 \mathrm{Lks}$. distance.
A Pine $24^{\prime \prime}$ in diameter bears $\mathrm{S} 20^{\circ} \mathrm{W}, 16 \mathrm{Lks}$. distance.
A Pine $34^{\prime \prime}$ in diameter bears $\mathrm{S} 72^{\circ} \mathrm{E}, 41 \mathrm{Lks}$. distance.
Description of corner evidence found:


No original corner evidence was found. Found a $24^{\prime \prime}$ Pine stump with blaze visible (BT at the base) bears $\mathrm{S} 20^{\circ} \mathrm{W}, 16 \mathrm{Lks}$.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I set a $5 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 30^{\prime \prime}$ iron rod with a $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ aluminum cap marked: at $\mathrm{N} 20^{\circ} \mathrm{E}, 16 \mathrm{Lks}$. from the above described original bearing tree stump.
