A Pine $40^{\prime \prime}$ diameter bears $\mathrm{S} 13^{\circ} \mathrm{E}, 58 \mathrm{Lks}$. distance
A Pine $9^{\prime \prime}$ diameter bears $\mathrm{S} 33^{\circ} \mathrm{W}, 59 \mathrm{Lks}$. distance

Description of corner evidence found:


No original corner evidence found. The following corner reference was found: A stump hole with rotted remains of portion of blaze overgrowth bears $\mathrm{S} 33^{\circ} \mathrm{W}, 59 \mathrm{Lks}$. ( $1 / 4 \mathrm{~S}$ ) visible.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this comer:

I set a $5 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 30^{\prime \prime}$ iron rod with a $1-1 / 2$ inch aluminum cap marked: at $\mathrm{N} 33^{\circ} \mathrm{E}, 59 \mathrm{Lks}$ from the above described original Section 23
