found a small slab wth a "B" scribed on it at a pine stump which bears S57*W 33 lks dist:


Description of monument and acceszories I establithed to perpetuate the original location of this cerner
At the polition of the corner I set a $2^{\prime \prime}$ galvanized pipe $30^{\prime \prime}$ long with an $8^{\prime \prime}$ plated welded to bottom and galvanized cap on top. The pipe set to a depth of $24^{\prime \prime}$ and back filled with tamped soil.

I stamped the disk

Frow the pipe the original bearing tree is: A pine stump bears $557^{\circ} \mathrm{W} 331 \mathrm{ks}$ dist;

I established new bearing trees as follows;
A fir $14^{\prime \prime}$ in diam bears $\$ 31^{\circ} \mathrm{E} 20.7^{\prime}$ scribed 4 SBT
A ponderosa pine $13^{\prime \prime}$ in diam bears $342^{\circ} \mathrm{E} 22.6 \mathrm{ft}$ scribed 4SBT;
