A wooden post was set for the section corner from which the following bearing trees were set:

A pine $34^{\prime \prime}$ dia. bears $N 45$ E 92 lks.
A pine 22" dia. bears 563 Y 57 Iks.
A pine 24" dia. bears S 55 E 58 lks.
A tamarack $5^{\prime \prime}$ dia. bears N $50 \mathrm{~W}, 23$ lks.


## Description of corner evidence lound:

Found evidence of the bearing tree stumps located in sections 24 , 25, and 26. Though stumps were badly rotted they fit the GLO call bearings and distances.

Restored section corner to its original position, using the GLO notes, thus I set a $5 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 30^{\prime \prime}$ ircn pin with cap stamped RLS 645, in a mound of stone. I then set four new bearing trees as follows: A fir $5^{\prime \prime}$ dia. which bears N 70 E, 16.3 feet scribed T 2 N R 39 E S 24 BT.
A fir $10^{\prime \prime}$ dia. bears $S 58 \mathrm{E}, 24.5$ feet, scribed $T 2 N \mathrm{R} 39 \mathrm{E}$ S 25 BT .
A fir ll" dia. bears S $41 \mathrm{~W}, 48.3$ feet, scribed T 2 NR 39 E S 26 BT .
A larch 4" dia. bears N 27 W, 16.3 feet scribed T 2 N R 39 E S 23 BT .
