## DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found Northeast bearing tree, blazes evident, did not open for scribes. Tree is now a $25^{\prime \prime}$ diameter Ponderosa Pine, with double blaze. Found numerous stones of called size in rock jack, but without marks.

Description of monument and accessories I established
tO perpetuate the original location of this corner:
At record bearing and distance from found bearing tree, I set a $2^{\frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}}$ aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, $23^{\prime \prime}$ in the ground and raised a mound of stone with a 2 ft base to top of cap. From which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:
An $8^{\prime \prime} x 8^{\prime \prime}$ railroad tie fence corner bears $N 30^{\circ}$ E, a distance of 3.35 f"eet.
A $25^{\prime \prime}$ diameter Ponderosa Pine ( original tree ) bears $N 8^{\circ} \mathrm{W}$, a distance of 70.00 feet, blazes evident.

A $28^{\prime \prime}$ diameter Ponderosa Pine bears $S 81^{\circ} \mathrm{W}$, a distance of 83.62 feet, marked $X \quad B T$.

A 20 " diameter Ponderosa Pine bears $N 21^{\circ} \mathrm{W}$, a distance of 51.76 feet, marked 34 S 18 BT .
