From which I add: An 18" pine bears SOloE, 57.4 ft. scribed UlR MP63 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-4s and brass washers stamped PlS 1051 on new BT. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on steel fence post 5' east of the corner.
