
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION




No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 16 inches in the ground, from which:

A 16 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S12°E, 85.37 feet marked C¼ S24 BT A 16 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S26°W, 51.04 feet marked C¼ S24 BT


Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with land survey monument sign attached.

Raised mound of stone around monument, 4 ft. base to top of cap.
