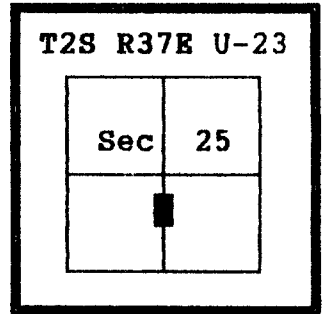


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position, determined by survey I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 22 inches in the ground, from which;

BEARING TREES

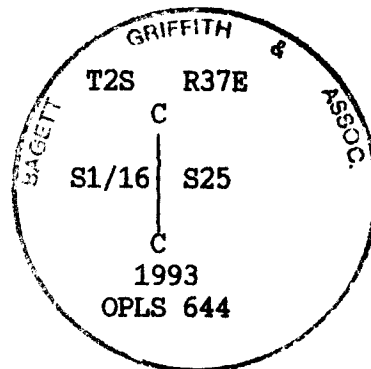
- A 25" White Fir bears S 33°E, 43.73 feet, marked X BT
- A 25" Douglas Fir bears N 47°W, 30.42 feet, marked CS1/16 S25 BT

Raised a small mound of stone around monument to top of cap.

I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
