

### DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

# TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 29 inches in the ground, from which:

#### **NEW BEARING TREES:**

A 5 inch Douglas Fir bears North 54° East, a distance of 8.35 feet, marked C1/4 S34 BT.

A 7 inch White Fir bears South 45° East, a distance of 16.65 feet, marked C1/4 S34 BT. A 13 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 26° West, a distance of 57.15 feet, marked C1/4 S34 BT. A 5 inch Western Larch bears North 45° West, a distance of 20.40 feet, marked C1/4 S34 BT.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 0.5 feet North of corner monument. Corner falls approximately 18 feet South of an East/West running fence.



I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 15° East. Bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower BT blaze. Distances are to at 60d spike in the right hand side of the tree.
