

History of original corner establishment:
Corner established by Frank W. Campbell under G.I.O. Contract \#507 in August, 1884. Surveyor's General's notes state: "Set a Fir post 4 ft . long, $4 \mathrm{ins}$. square 25 ins. in ground for corner to Secs. 4,5,32 and 33 marked T4N S33 on N.E. T3N S4 on S.E. R4OE S5 on S.W. and S32 on N. W. face with 4 notches on the East and 2 notches on $W$. fdges: from which: A Spruce 28 ins. diam. bears N16 E, 65lks. dist. marked T4N R4OE S33BT..A A Spruce 12 ins. diam. bears $S 32^{E}, 54 \mathrm{ks}$. dist. marked T3N R4OE S4BT.. A Spruce 27 ins. diam. bears $510^{\circ} \mathrm{W}, 327 \mathrm{ks}$. dist. marked $T 3 \mathrm{~N}$ R4OE S5BT.. A Spruce 24 ins. diam. bears $N 80^{\circ} \mathrm{W}$, 381 ks . dist. marked T4N R4OE S32BT.."

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of wood post.
Found a White Fir snag $38^{\prime \prime}$ in dia. bears $N 21^{\circ} \mathrm{E}, 45.5$ feet, with some visible scribing. A White Fir snag $33^{\prime \prime}$ in dia. with old blazes and burnt out corner, $S 07^{0} W, 21.1$ feet. A White Fir snag $36^{\prime \prime}$ in dia. with grown over blazes, bears N790w, 20.4 feet. Trees have old Oregon Forestry board tags and 54-3s.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:
Set $2 \frac{1}{2} " \mathrm{x} 30$ " galvanized pipe with brass cap marked: Set pipe $26^{\prime \prime}$ in the ground.

No rock in area.

Set: Fir post $4^{\prime}$ long, $4^{\prime \prime}$ square, $25^{\prime \prime}$ in ground. Marked: 28" Spruce N16E, $65 \mathrm{lks} .-12 "$ Spruce S32E, 54 1ks.- 27 " Spruce S10W, 32 1ks.-24" Spruce N80W, 38 1ks Corner was reestablished by OR PLS 1051 in 1978.
Found: 38" Wh. Fir snag N21E, 45.5'-33" Wh. Fir snag S7W, 21.1'-36" Wh. Fir snag N79W, 20.4'.


Set: $2 \frac{1}{2} " x 30^{\prime \prime}$ gal. pipe with brass cap $26^{\prime \prime}$ in ground.

Nailed 54-3 and 54-9 signs to BT's and painted bands and blazes red.
Set guard posts West and South with 54-2 signs, one with 54-9 sign.
Pine is Ponderosa Pine.
