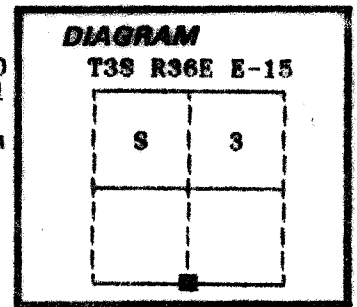


UNION COUNTY
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by John H. Hurlburt under GLO Contract Number 201, dated August 5, 1873. Surveyor General record states:
Set Post 4 inches square in ground in. for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. from which;



A 20 inch diameter Pine bears N28- $\frac{1}{2}$ °E, 106 Lks.
A 40 inch diameter Pine bears S31°W, 89 Lks.

No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner monument.
Area had been logged and burned.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At the proportionate position, determined by survey I set a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 27 inches in the ground, from which;

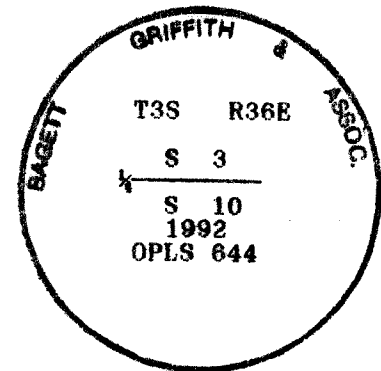
New Bearing Trees;

- A 12 inch diameter Ponderosa pine bears N74°E, 32.92 feet marked X BT
- A 10 inch diameter Ponderosa pine bears S41°E, 21.93 feet marked X BT
- A 13 inch diameter Ponderosa pine bears S3°W, 36.47 feet marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S10 BT
- A 15 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N63°W, 7.64 feet marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S3 BT

Raised a small mound of stone.
Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet East, with a 54-9 sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on July 13, 1992.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 20° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
