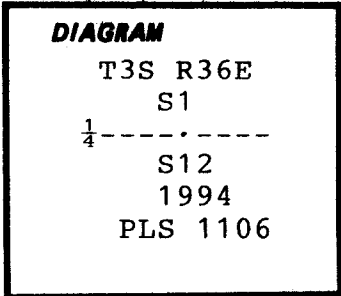


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

E-23

History of original corner establishment:
Corner was originally established by John A. Hurlburt, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under contract No. 201, dated August 5, 1873. Surveyor General records state:



Set a basalt stone 15 X 12 X 6, 10 in. in ground for 1/4 sec cor.

Description of corner evidence found:

None, area has been heavily farmed.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the mid-point between the found corners at the SW and SE corners of Section 1:
Set a 2 1/2" X 30" aluminum pipe with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap, buried 18" below the ground surface in a plowed field.
Attached sign 54-9 to a 6' steel fence post, set 4' East of monument.
New bearing trees and reference monument established:
A 5/8" x 30" rebar with a 1 1/2" aluminum cap stamped "RM, ←---, 225.4', 1994, PLS 1106" bears N 70 1/2° E - 225.4'. A steel fence post bears N 70° E - 2' from the reference monument.
A 20" ponderosa pine bears S 13 1/2° W - 326.8', scribed "1/4S12BT".
A 28" ponderosa pine bears S 84 1/2° W - 336.4', scribed "1/4S12BT".
A 22" ponderosa pine bears N 25 1/4° W - 499.9', scribed "1/4S1BT".
New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped "PLS 1106" nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" band red on each bearing tree.

Bearing trees and reference monument were tied using a Sokkia Automatic Total Station.

I hereby certify that the above corner monument was properly monumented to U.S.F.S standards on November 4, 1994.

Compass declination 18° East.
