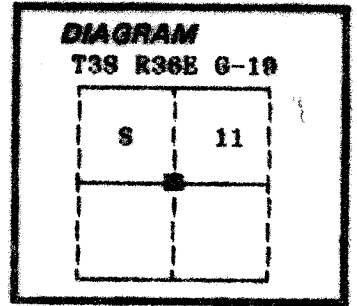


UNION COUNTY
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:
This corner was never established.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

See Map of Survey Number 028-1992.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position, determined by survey I set a 2 1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 27 inches in the ground, from which;

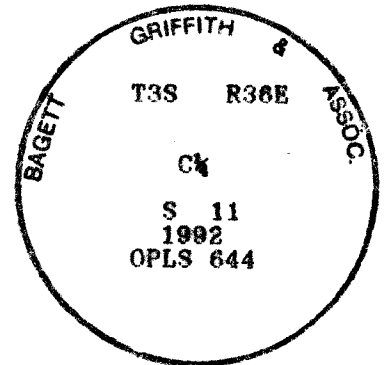
New Bearing Trees;

- A 24 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N21°E, 90.74 feet marked C 1/4 S11 BT
- A 20 inch diameter Cottonwood bears S52°E, 59.69 feet marked C 1/4 S11 BT bark scribed
- A 14 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N11°W, 106.39 feet marked C 1/4 S11 BT
- A 24 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N32°W, 90.31 feet marked C 1/4 S11 BT

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet North, with a 54-9 sign attached.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 20° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
