History of original corner establishment:

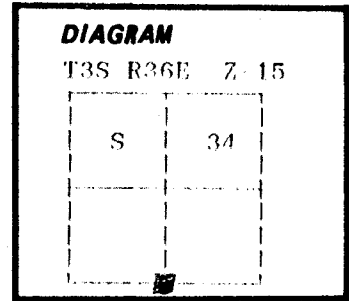
Corner originally established by John A. Hurlburt under GLO contract number 201, dated August 5, 1873. Surveyor General record states:

Set fir post 4 ft. long 3 in. thick 2 ft. in ground for 1/4 sec cor

Fir 20 in dia N76°E 38 lks
Pine 24 in dia S51°W 71 lks

Corner found by Herman D. Graden on GLO contract number 452, dated June 16, 1882. Surveyor General record states:

The 1/4 cor a post with 2 bearing trees



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner or it's accessories.

See Union County Survey Number 25-89

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 29 inches in the ground, from which;

New Bearing Trees;

- A 7 inch diameter Western Larch bears N63°E, 40.95 feet marked X BT
- A 9 inch diameter Western Larch bears N40°W, 28.74 feet marked 1/4 S34 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with Land Survey Monument sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on September 30, 1989.
