



DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a brass cap set in a water valve box with markings as described on Monumentation Record No. 008-1991R. During 2012, this area was regraded as part of a construction project to improve and widen Pierce Road. The water valve case was removed and replaced during construction with a "MON" case. The monument was preserved undisturbed through construction activities. All of the accessories of record were removed.




