

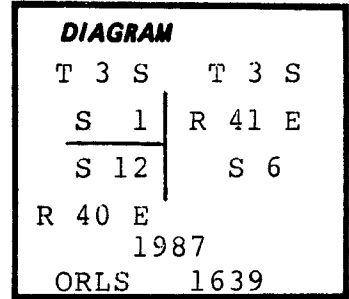
**CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

E-25

**History of original corner establishment:**

Corner established by W.B.Barr under contract No. 355 and dated June 14, 1880.

Surveyor General records state: Marked a tamarack 18" diam for corner to Sec 1 x 6 x 7 x 12 from which: Fir 12 in dia brs S85°W, 12 lks dist. Fir 5" dia brs N40°W, 24 lks dis. Fir 4" dia brs S84°E, 13 lks dist. Pine 15" dia brs S10°E 83 lks dist.



Corner REESTABLISHED by Alonzo Gesner under contract No. 683 and dated June 7, 1898, and his records state: The cor to Secs 1 and 12 range 40 E which is a tree but destroyed by forest fires. I reestablished it as follows: Set basalt stone 20x10x5", 15" in ground mkd with 5 notches on the S and 1 notch on N side from which: A pine 18" dia brs N64°W, 30 lks dist mkd T3SR40ES1 BT. A tamarack 20" dia brs S68°W, 54 lks T3SR40ES12 BT. Note, the bearing trees (old survey) have been killed by forest fires.

**Description of corner evidence found:**

Found basalt stone 22 x 11 x 4" (record, 20 x 10 x 5") in place well marked with 5 notches on S and 1 notch on N faces from which:

A tamarack 23" dia brs S64½°W, 34.0' (record, S68°W, 54 lks) with healed double blaze.  
A rotten root stub brs N64°W, 30 lks per record with no scribes.

**Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

At position of found stone...

Set 2½" aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 25" in ground & 5" projecting out of ground with surrounding rock mound & 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Buried stone alongside.

**New bearing trees established:**

A tamarack 15" dia brs N47°W, 44.2' dist marked T3SR40ES1 BT.

Each BT has a sign 54-3 and signs 54-4 or 54-9 attached below a 6" band of red paint, and each new BT has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.

Compass declination 17° East.

I hereby certify that the above described corner monument was properly remonumented by me and witnessed by Jim DeMastus on August 20, 1987.
