Set $2^{\prime \prime} \times 30^{\prime \prime}$ galvanized iron pipe with $2 \frac{1}{2} " 1$ brass cap marked: Pipe is set in ground $26^{\prime \prime}$ with a collar of stone. A steel fence post is set $5^{\prime}$ from the brass cap with a USFS Land Survey Monument sign attached.
New Bearing Trees:
