Old Book 1 Page 84 states set stone 4"x10"x24" for 1/8 corner Survey No. 040-2002 establishes proportionate position

Found "1/8" chiseled in 3"x10"x26" stone set firmly in mound of stone

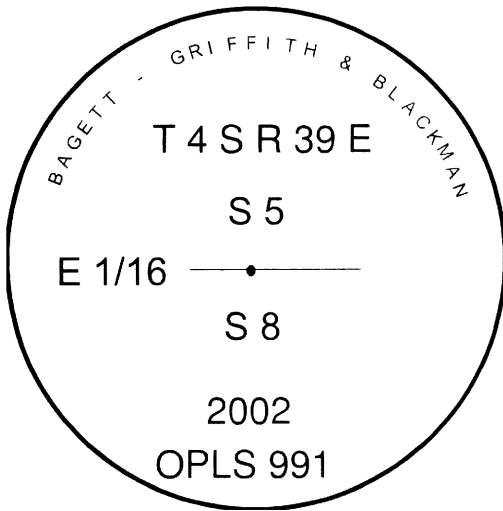
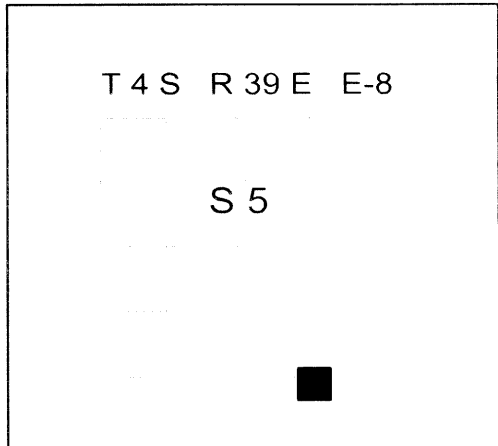
**TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:**

At the position of found stone, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with 2 1/2" aluminum cap, marked as shown, 29 inches in the ground, from which  
NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with 1 1/2" aluminum cap, bears North 44° East, a distance of 22.67 feet, in fenceline marked BGB SURVEY MARKER NE RP.  
A 5/8"x30" iron pin with 1 1/2" aluminum cap, bears North 24° West, a distance of 18.00 feet, in fenceline marked BGB SURVEY MARKER NW RP.

Buried found stone alongside monument. Monument is 17 ft. South of East-West fenceline. Set steel fencepost 1 ft. North of monument
