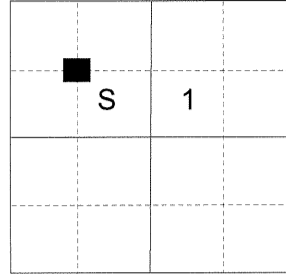

**NEW BEARING OBJECTS:**

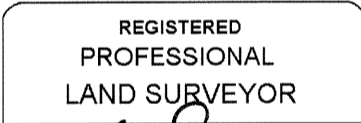
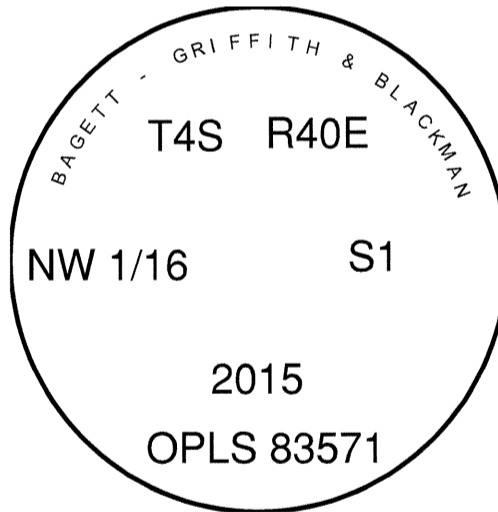
A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears North 34° East, a distance of 33.80 feet, marked NW 1/16 S1 BT.

A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears South 57° East, a distance of 33.25 feet, marked NW 1/16 S1 BT.

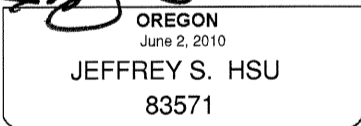
I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of corner monument.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 16° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
