I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the accessories. I used 16° East declination, the distance to the Northeast bearing tree is to a 60d spike driven into the root crown at the right side of the tree. The distance to the Southwest tree is to a 60d spike driven into the root crown at the left side of the tree. I place a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower blaze of the accessories.
