Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position of the corner I set a 30" galvanized pipe with an eight inch plate welded to bottom and a bronze cap on top. The hole was back filled with stone and tamped soil.

I stamped the disk.

From the monument the original bearing tree was; Pine 28" dia. N53°E, 32 lks dist. marked #SBT. I established the following neww bearing tree; Red Fir 8" dia., 332"W at a distance of 2.9 ft. and scribed

The distance measured to center of respective trees on level. I placed bearing tree signs on both old and new bearing trees and painted stripe around trees. I placed a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 attached near the corner.
