Description of manuscrat and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position of the corner I set a  $2^{\text{H}}$  galvanized pipe  $30^{\text{H}}$  long and a  $8^{\text{H}}$  plate welded to bottom. The pipe set to a depth of  $21^{\text{H}}$  and back filled with stone and soil. A bronze cap was placed on top of pipe.

I stamped the disk
