History of original corner establishment:

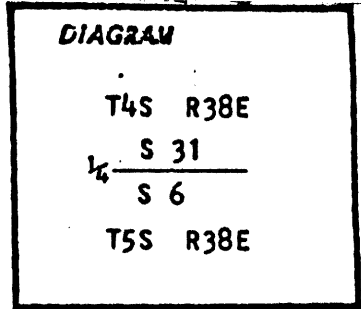
Corner established in 1863 by Timothy W. Davenport under General Land Office Contract No. 102.

Surveyor General Record states:

Set post for corner from which;

A spruce 8 in. dia. bears N20E, 8 links

A spruce 8 in. dia. bears S15E, 10 links



Retraced in 1881 by W.B. Barr under General Land Office Contract No. 388.

No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in County records.

Description of corner evidence found:

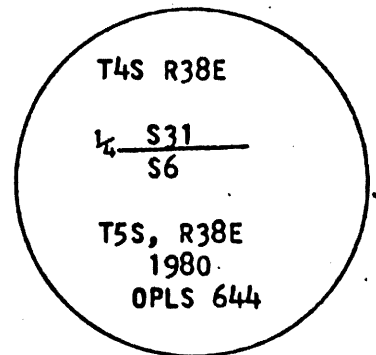
Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At proportionate distance I set 2 1/2" x 30" iron pipe with brass cap marked as shown, 14" in ground, from which:

A 7" lodgepole pine bears N49E, 20.7 feet marked 1/4 S31 BT

A 7" lodgepole pine bears S45E, 12.8 feet marked 1/4 S. 6 B T

Raised mound of stone.
