A careful examination of the dead & down 72" ponderosa pine indicates the tree did not twist as it fell and that the blaze did in fact face Southwest while it was still standing. Evidence that supports this is the shape of the root wad and the shape of the root hole match. Also the pieces of root still in the ground match pieces of the root wad still attached to the tree showing the position of the blaze on the Southwest side of the tree. Other supporting evidence is the distance more closely fits to the standard corner closed on in the original survey and the bearing to the section corner south is closer to parallel to the range line and the other two north-south section lines to the west.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

No permanent monument was set at the original closing corner location.
