The stone of record with markings was found.
A slab frow a tree with markings for S3 was found.
A scribe was found on rotten log for section 10.
A shag 12 k in diam bears $N 65^{\circ} \mathrm{E} 30 \mathrm{kss}$ dist.
A pine $\log 24^{\prime \prime}$ in diam (now down) bears $50^{\circ} \mathrm{E} 32 \mathrm{lks}$ dist.


## Description of menumpant and cecescorles I established te perpetuate the original location of this corner

I set a $2^{\prime \prime}$ galvanized pipe $30^{\prime \prime}$ long with bronze cap an top and a $\beta^{\prime \prime}$ pate welded to bottom. The pipe is set to depth of $24^{\prime \prime}$ and hole beck filled with stone and packed soil. The marked stone placed by the pipe with top showing.

A fallen pine $\log 24^{\prime \prime}$ in diam(bears $350^{\circ} \mathrm{E} 32 \mathrm{lks}$ distanced
