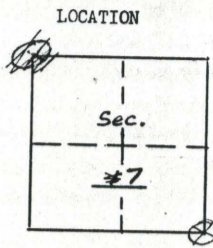

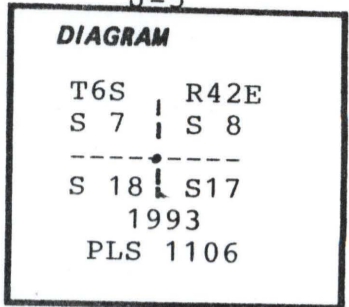

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

J-5



History of original corner establishment:
 Corner was originally established by W.B. BARR, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 443, dated May 29, 1882. Surveyor General records state:
 Set a volcanic rock 14"X 12"X 8", 10 inches in the ground. Stone was marked with 5 notches on the north and 4 notches on the south, from which:
 A 18" pine bears N62°E-81 lks dist., scribed T6SR42E S8BT., A 14" pine bears S73°E-120 lks dist., scribed T6SR42ES17BT., A 18" pine bears S55°W-83 lks dist., scribed T6SR42ES18BT., A 26" pine bears N45°W-48 lks dist., scribed T6SR42ES7BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone 13"X 10"X 7", 1/2" in the ground with 5 notches on the North and 4 notches on the south.
 A live 33" ponderosa pine bears N45°W-31.7 feet, scribed: T6SR42ES7, with open blaze and a bearing tree tag.
 A 12" stump bears S73°E-79.2 feet, scribed: T6SR42ES17 with bearing tree tag.
 A log with a bearing tree tag and a rotten stump hole bears S55°W-54.8 feet.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the postion of the found stone:

Set a 2 1/2" X 30" aluminum pipe with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap, 24" in ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Deposited stone in hole along side of monument.

Attached sign 54-9 to steel fence post, set 3.0 feet North of monument.

New bearing trees established:

- A 14" ponderosa pine bears S 31 1/2° W - 4.1 feet, scribed: T6SR42ES18BT.
- A 23" ponderosa pine bears N 2 1/2° E - 32.6 feet, scribed: T6SR42ES8BT.
- A 23" douglas fir bears S 35 1/2° E - 23.7 feet, scribed: T6SR42ES17BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped "PLS 1106" nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

I hereby certify that the above corner monument was properly monumented to U.S.F.S standards by me on December 1, 1993.
