History of original corner establishment:
Corner was originally established by W.B. BARR, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 443, dated May 29, 1882. Surveyor General records state: Set a basalt rock $20^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{X} 18^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{X} 8^{\prime \prime}$, set 15 inches in the ground and marked with a $1 / 4$ on the North face.

## See Survey 052-1994 <br> Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone 20 "X 14 "X 6 ", set in a small mound of stone with $1 / 4$ chiseled on the North face. There is evidence of an old E.W. fence and a N.S. fence at this location.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of the found stone:
Set a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " X $30^{\prime \prime}$ aluminum pipe with a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, $26^{\prime \prime}$ in ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Deposited stone in hole along side of monument.
Attached sign 54-9 \& 54-2 to steel fence post, set 3.6 feet North of monument.

New bearing objects established:
A $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ X $30^{\prime \prime}$ rebar bears N $73^{\circ} \mathrm{E}$ - 19.6 feet, with a $1 \frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime}$ aluminum cap stamped "RM $\frac{1}{4}$ S18-19.6 FT 1106".
A $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ X $30^{\prime \prime}$ rebar bears N $33^{\circ} \mathrm{W}-19.6$ feet, with a $1 \frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime}$ aluminum cap stamped "RM $\frac{1}{4}$ S18-19.6 FT 1106".
A $5 / 8^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{X} 30^{\prime \prime}$ rebar bears $S 55 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} \mathrm{W}-22.6$ feet, with a $1 \frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime}$ aluminum cap stamped "RM $\frac{1}{4}$ S19-22.6 FT 1106".
A $5 / 8^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{X} 30^{\prime \prime}$ rebar bears S $27^{\circ} \mathrm{E}-23.9$ feet, with a $1 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ aluminum cap stamped "RM $\frac{1}{4}$ S19-23.9 FT 1106".
