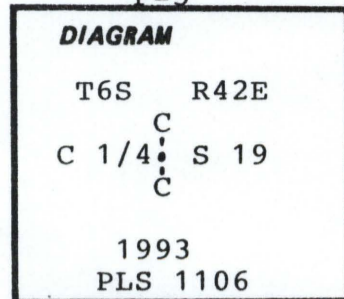


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At postion established by survey:

Set a 2 1/2" X 30" aluminum pipe with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap, 29" in ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone.

Attached sign 54-9 to steel fence post, set 3.5 feet North of monument.

New bearing trees established:

- A 26" ponderosa pine bears N 12° W - 92.7 feet, scribed: C1/4S19BT.
- A 17" ponderosa pine bears N 35° E - 89.9 feet, scribed: C1/4S19BT.
- A 21" ponderosa pine bears S 42° E - 40.1 feet, scribed: C1/4S19BT.
- A 17" ponderosa pine bears S 31° W - 63.0 feet, scribed: C1/4S19BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped "PLS 1106" nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each bearing tree.
