## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:
80.00 Set basalt rock $12 \times 10 \times 8$ ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for corner to secs. 20, 21, 28, and 29. Marked with 4 notches on the East and 2 notches on the South edge, from which:

A pine, 26 ins. diam., bears N. $75^{\circ}$ E., 72 ilks. dist. mad. T6S

A pine, 15 ins. diam., bears S. $16^{\circ}$ E., 85 lks . dist. mad. T6S R42E S28 BT. No other trees with in links. raised mound of rock alongside. Pits impracticable.

## Description of corner evidence found:

A pine stump, $20^{\prime \prime}$ diam., bears $\mathrm{S} .16^{\circ} \mathrm{E}$., $56.10^{\prime}$, scribing visible in blaze.
A log/root hole, $26^{\prime \prime}$ diam., bears N. $75^{\circ}$ E., 47.5'.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

No evidence of original monument found. Position established from using record bearing and distance from found original bearing tree stump. Set a $3^{\prime \prime}$ diam. U.S.F.S aluminum capped pipe, 30 " long, with magnet, $2^{\prime \prime}$ in ground with mound of stone to cap, from which:

A chiseled hole, bears N. $27^{\circ} 54^{\prime} \mathrm{W}$., $92.54^{\prime}$.
A chiseled hole, bears S.18²1'E., 44.88'.
A pine, $7^{\prime \prime}$ diam., bears $N .77^{\circ} 31^{\prime} W ., 90.43^{\prime}$, scribed "X BT".
A pine, $15^{\prime \prime}$ diam., bears N. $77^{\circ} 59^{\prime}$ E., 61.57', scribed "T6S R42E S21 BT".
