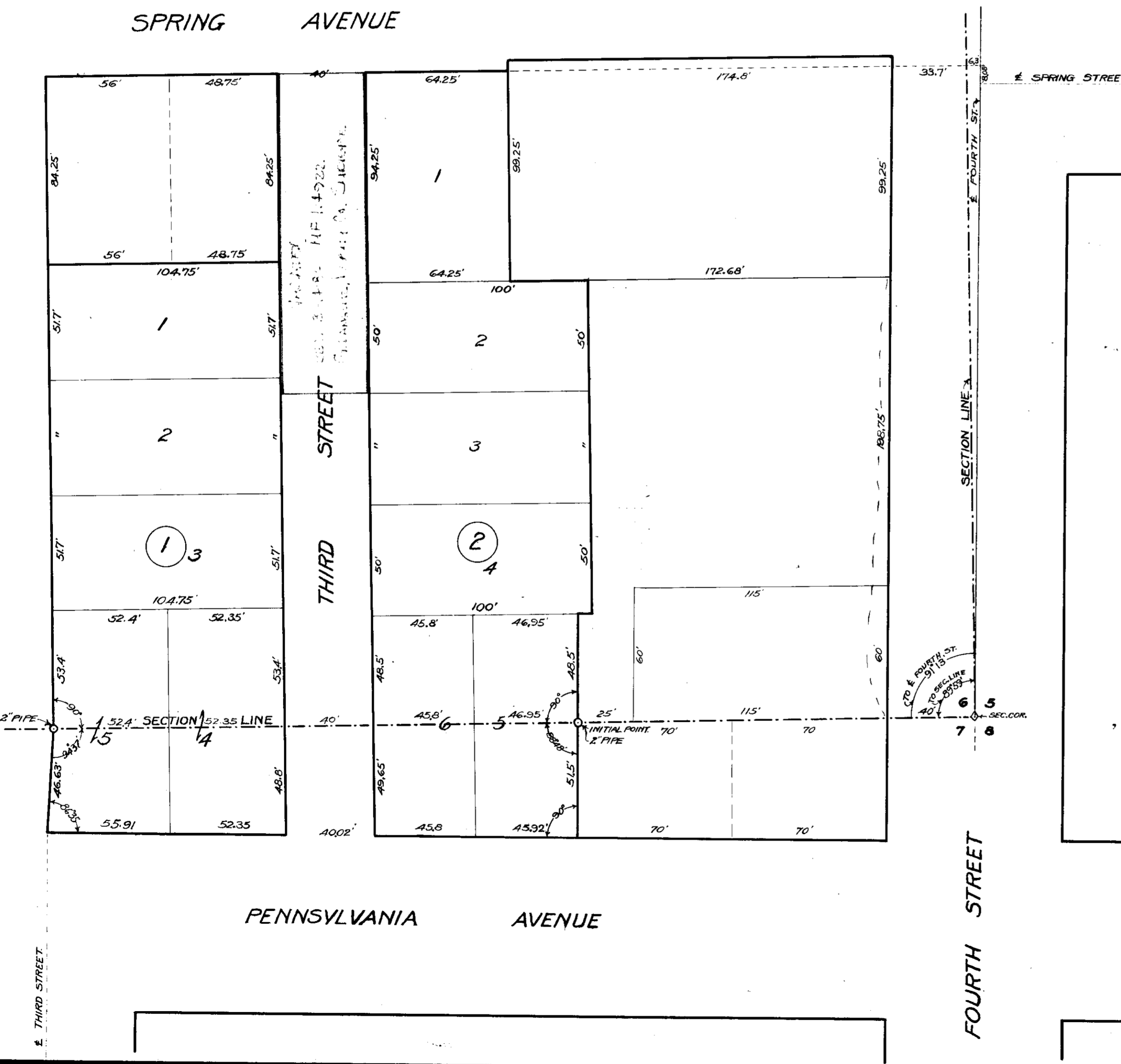


ANSON PLACE IN LA GRANDE, UNION COUNTY, OREGON.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:
 That Margaret Anson, owner of the following described tract of land; Beginning at a point on the section corner between sections 6 and 7, 180 feet west of the section corner common to sections 5-6-7-8, Township 3 South, Range 38 East, W.M. thence at an angle of 88°48' to the left and in a southerly direction a distance of 51.5 feet; thence 90° right 240 feet; thence 93°25' right 46.63 feet; thence 4°37' left 208.5 feet; thence 90° right 104.75 feet; thence 90° left 84.25 feet; thence 90° right 104.25 feet; thence 90° right 94.25 feet; thence 90° left 35.75 feet; thence 90° right 150 feet; thence 90° right 725 feet; thence 90° left 48.5 feet to point of beginning and have caused the same to be subdivided into blocks, lots, and streets of the sizes and dimensions as shown on this plat to be known hereafter as Anson Place La Grande, Oregon, and I hereby dedicate to public use forever the portion shown as THIRD STREET.

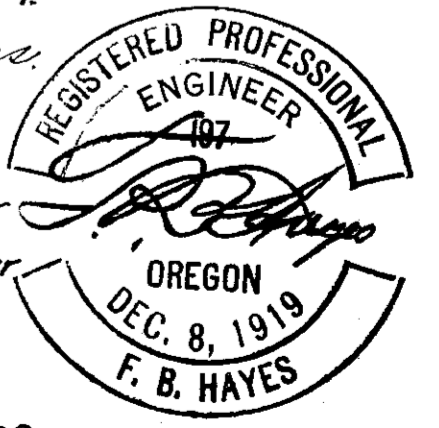
