

AFFIDAVIT OF SURVEYOR

STATE OF OREGON, ss. COUNTY OF UNION. I, ARTHUR H. RUDD, BEING FIRST DULY SWORN, SAY THAT I AM THE SURVEYOR WHO ON THE 11<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF MAY 1910 BEGAN THE SURVEY HEREIN DESCRIBED AND ON THE 17<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF NOVEMBER 1910, I COMPLETED THE SURVEYING AND MARKING OUT OF THE LAND EMBRACED IN THE FOLLOWING DESCRIPTION TO WIT: BEGINNING AT THE N.W. COR. ELGIN AVENUE AND FOURTH STREET, CITY OF ELGIN A BASALT STONE CHISELED + ON TOP, THENCE S 87° 16' W, 716 FT., THENCE N. 1° 31' W, 3064.25 FT. TO A BASALT STONE CHISELED + ON TOP, THENCE N. 87° 46' E, 2097.65 FT. TO A 1/2" GALVANIZED PIPE, 3' LONG, DRIVEN 3' INTO THE GROUND, THENCE SOUTHWESTERLY CHANGING TO SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF THE RIGHT OF WAY OF THE O.R.N.R.R. TO A 1/2" GALVANIZED PIPE, 3' LONG, DRIVEN 3' INTO THE GROUND, THENCE S 87° 16' W, 1075 FT. TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING THE SAME TO BE NAMED AND KNOWN AND NAMED IN THE DEED OF DEDICATION HEREWITH AS "HUG'S ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF ELGIN, INCLUDING A PORTION OF HINDMAN'S ADDITION WHICH IS HEREBY AMENDED" AND THAT I HAVE CORRECTLY SURVEYED AND MARKED WITH PROPER MONUMENTS THE LANDS AS REPRESENTED IN THE SUBJOINED PLAT.

HUG, HIS WIFE FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE BENEFITS ACCRUED AND TO ACCRUE TO US, OUR HEIRS AND ASSIGNS BY AND FROM THE SALE OF LOTS AND BLOCKS IN THE TRACT OF LAND REPRESENTED BY THE SUBJOINED PLAT, TO WIT: BEGINNING AT THE N.W. COR. ELGIN AVENUE AND FOURTH STREET, CITY OF ELGIN, A BASALT STONE CHISELED + ON TOP, THENCE S 87° 16' W, 716 FT., THENCE N. 1° 31' W, 3064.25 FT., TO A BASALT STONE CHISELED + ON TOP, THENCE N 87° 46' E, 2097.65 FT. TO A 1/2" GALVANIZED PIPE, 3' LONG, DRIVEN 3' INTO THE GROUND, THENCE SOUTHWESTERLY CHANGING TO SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF THE RIGHT OF WAY OF THE O.R.N.R.R. TO A 1/2" GALVANIZED PIPE 3' LONG DRIVEN 3' IN THE GROUND, THENCE S 87° 16' W, 1075 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING AND TO BE KNOWN UNDER THE NAME AND STYLE OF "HUG'S ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF ELGIN, INCLUDING A PORTION OF HINDMAN'S ADDITION WHICH IS HEREBY AMENDED," DO HEREBY FOREVER DEDICATE TO THE PUBLIC THE FREE AND UNOBSTRUCTED USE AND BENEFIT OF ALL LAND THEREIN REPRESENTED, SURVEYED AND MARKED OUT WITH SUITABLE MONUMENTS AS STREETS AND ALLEYS.

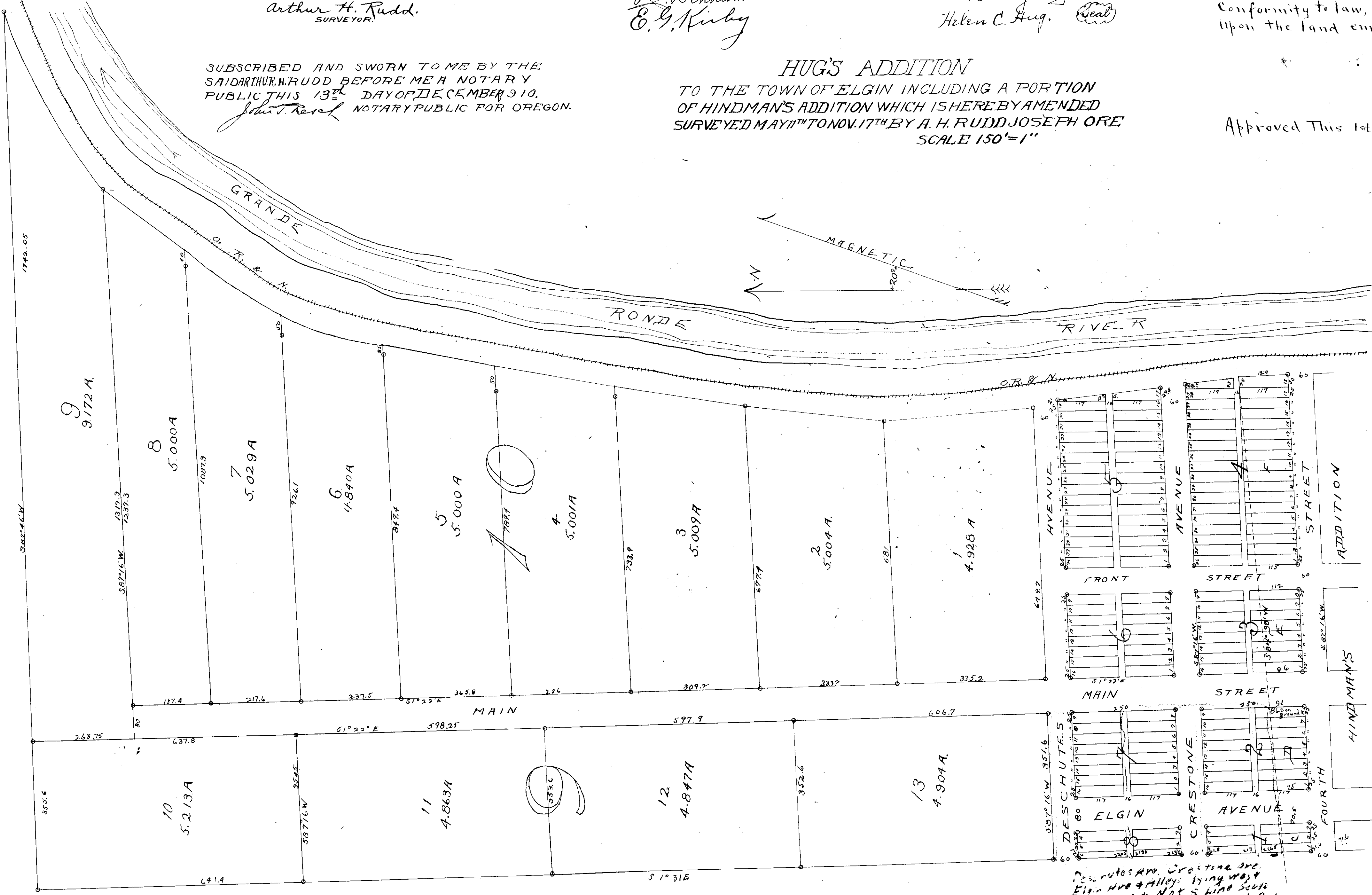
