NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Joyce Pressler. I found iron pipes from the 1922 remonumentation of La Grande at the intersections along Third Street. The position of the intersections along Second Street were previously established by survey number 20-80. From these intersection positions I establish the block corners and the corners of this parcel. I find the existing fences in the area of the Northwest corner of this parcel to be harmonious as shown. I find no unusual conditions with this survey.

Note: Monument destroyed by construction. Position established by previous coordinate ties.
