NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Jeff Puckett, of Pioneer Federal Savings and Loan, to locate the parcel hereon shown. I find the monument at the intersection of Cove Avenue and North Willow Street destroyed. I place this intersection position at record distance and bearing from the section corner monument, as shown on survey no. 6-81. This also agrees with the position as determined by ties to the monument prior to destruction. The monument at the intersection of East O Avenue and North Willow Street is approximately 2 feet below the street surface. I place this position by fies to the monument prior to being covered. This also fits with field ties to the monument at North Willow and East M Avenue as shown. I then locate East O Avenue by going the record bearing and distance of survey no. 86-78 Westerly to the West line of Honans Addition. I then drive a line N 00°19'58" E (the record bearing of survey nos. 86-78 and 4-84) to its intersection with Cove Avenue to locate the West line of block I. I then break the block into lots by standard proportion. I find monuments from survey nos. 78 and 24-71 as shown. These surveys used call distance (210 feet) from the South line of Cove Avenue and did not proportion the North -South shortage. This is why they are South of my location for the East - West centerline of block i.

This parcel is described as the West 60 feet of the East 70 feet of lot 3, however in retracing the deeds, I find that when originally purchased by William Page (deed volume II8 page 593), the West line of this parcel is specifically called "parallel with and I30 feet from the West line" of block I. This deed also conveys a portion of lot 4. At a later date Mr. Page sold the West 60 feet of this parcel. I therefore give it full measure East and West and treat the parcel to the East as a remnant, giving it approximately 9 feet instead of I0 as called for by deed. I find no other unusual conditions.
