

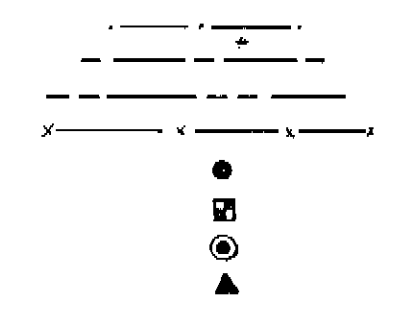
Basis of Bearing

Narrative

This survey was requested by Leta Grubbe for the purpose of locating the property described in micro film 89687 in the Union County deed records. I found this property to have senior rights so the full distance was given the boundaries as shown. Directions on lines were indicated as 90° angles. Standard single proportioning was done along the north line of section 16. No other problems were encountered and the survey was completed as shown.
