The original common line between these parcels were described as aliquot portions of the Sections. I place the adjusted line at the record aliquot dimensions at the direction of Mr. Bean. The most Northerly monument is a reference to the centerline of the Grande Ronde River. I find no other unusual conditions on this survey.
