NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Ray Crapo on behalf of the City of La Grande Public Works. Mr. Crapo wanted to monument the centerline of a portion of North Willow Street following a paving project. The position of the intersections was placed by retracement of Survey 24-82, 6-88, 040-2000 and 035-2006. These surveys are harmonious with each other, but due to slight discrepancies between the measurements, I calculate a best fit location to maintain harmony with all of these surveys. Due to the lack of curbs in the area, I chisel crosses in water valve and manhole rims as accessories. The original plat of Williamson's Addition shows a 30 foot right of way, however in the 1922 McIn survey, he monuments the centerline of the current 40 foot right of way. I follow McIn and place the monuments at the center of the 40 foot right of way. I find no other unusual conditions with this survey.
